## **4.2 ENTRY PROCEDURE**

**4.2.1** Anyone wishing to take part in the 69 Rally Costa Brava must use the **FIA Online Registration Platform**.

All crews who wish to score points in the EHRC must make their entries by using the standard entry form for their championship available in the FIA application at: <a href="https://registrations.fia.com/EHRC">https://registrations.fia.com/EHRC</a>

**4.2.2** Any other crews who are not registered in the <u>EHRC</u> and who are therefore not wishing to collect points in the EHRC, must use and send the entry form available at <a href="https://registrations.fia.com/EHRC\_1ESP">https://registrations.fia.com/EHRC\_1ESP</a> duly completed before the closing date of entries.

Please note that the FIA registration platform requires a user ID and a password to access the entry system. The FIA will need time to register you in the system and open your user account. Please do not wait until the last moment to make your entry in order not to miss the entry closing date.

## 4.2.3 Acceptance of Entry Form

The entry application will only be accepted if duly completed and accompanied by the bank transfer of the total amount of the entry fee to the Organiser's bank account, or the receipt of the Credit Card payment.





## **4.3 NUMBER OF ENTRIES ACCEPTED AND CLASSES**

**4.3.1** The maximum number of entries accepted will be 300, all categories included. If more than 300 entries are received, the Organisers reserve the sole right to decide which entries among the EHRC non-registered drivers will be accepted.

## 4.3.2 Cars eligible to enter the event

#### **4.4 ENTRY FEES**

The entry fees for the Competition are fixed at € 1095 per car.

## 4.4.1 Entry packages

- Entry fee with discount (Before 01/01/2021): 100 Euro discount.
- Discount for cars with engine capacity lower than 1300cc: 200 Euro discount.
- Discount for cars with engine capacity between 1301cc and 2000cc: 100 Euro discount.
- Additional Service Sticker: 100 Euro

## **4.6 REFUNDS**

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- a) To candidates whose entry has not been accepted.
- b) In the case of the Rally not taking place.

(Organisers may refund 80% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reasons of "force majeure", duly certified by their ASN, were unable to start in the Rally.)

If the event is cancelled by the authorities for reasons of "force majeure" at least one week before the start of the rally, the 70 Rally Costa Brava will be held in March 2022, and the entries will be kept for the new date. If any team cannot come on the new date, will get a 90% of the entry fee refund.

## **5. INSURANCE**

The organiser provides the following insurance: Zurich Insurance PLC Sucursal en España. Insurance Policy nº96.119.524

Insurance cover will come into effect from the start and will cease at the end of the Rally or at the moment of withdrawal or disqualification of the Competitor.

The Insurance covers up to 70.000.000 Euro per incident for personal damages.

The insurance covers up to 15.000.000 Euro per incident for material damages.





#### 6. ADVERTISING & IDENTIFICATION

All advertising or sponsorship of tobacco products on clothing, complements, instruments, equipment, prototypes and / or vehicles of teams participating in motor sports competitions or events is banned by law.

#### 7. TYRES

#### 7.1 NUMBER OF TYRES & TYRE MARKING PROCEDURE

## 7.1.1 Eligible tyres

All tyres used for rally stages on tarmac and road sections must be marked «E» or «DOT» in accordance with the appropriate standard of the country in which the Competition is taking place. They must have a minimum external diameter corresponding to the period in question (see Article 8.4.2 of Appendix K) and they must not be marked «*Not for highway use*» nor «*For Racing Only*» nor imply any indication limiting, specifying or recommending a use in competition. Any alteration, modification or adaptation (which for the avoidance of doubt includes cutting of additional grooves) of tyres other than wear through normal use is forbidden. For stages run on gravel, and so declared by the clerk of the course, no «E» or «DOT» tyre marking is necessary.

<u>a) Cars of Category 1</u>: During Competitions classed as tarmac event (i.e. excluding gravel or snow Competitions) there shall be **a maximum of 14 tyres permitted**. Tyres must be uniquely identified with a barcode (or such other method as may be prescribed) and registered with the FIA eligibility delegate before the start of the Competition.

Checks for compliance with this regulation may be undertaken at any time during the Competition and any discrepancies will be reported to the stewards. A detailed information sheet will be available before each Competition.

b) Cars of Category 2, 3 and 4: During Competitions classed as tarmac (i.e. excluding gravel or snow Competitions) there shall be a maximum of 10 tyres said «dry» permitted. Tyres must be uniquely identified with a barcode (or such other method as may be prescribed) and registered with the FIA eligibility delegate before the start of the Competition.

Due to the lack of availability of «wet» tyres in their appropriate sizes, the cars listed as exceptions in the appendix to the FIA authorized wet tyre list may register a maximum of 14 tyres before the start of the Competition. Thus there is no allowance for additional «wet» tyres.

Checks for compliance with this regulations may be undertaken at any time during the Competition and any discrepancies will be reported to the stewards. The number of «wet» tyres is not limited. Only the «wet» tyres as per the FIA authorised tyre list can be used. A detailed information sheet will be available before each Competition.

## **7.1.2 Tyre marking** is obligatory for all the competitors.

All tyres must have a specific barcode number supplied by the 2021 FIA-approved barcode supplier. All tyres must be registered with the FIA Eligibility delegate before the start of the rally, at pre-event scrutineering.

The cars must be presented at the tyre Marking Zone with their spare wheels placed with the outer part of the rim on top, and if needed, unfastened, to facilitate the procedure. Following the marking,





and before the cars departure from the tyre marking area, crews, or their team member, must properly fasten the spare wheels as required.

## 7.1.3 Tyre Marking during the rally

A wheel/tyre marking / barcode reading zone may be established at the exit of the authorised service parks or remote service zones and at the start of a stage.

The crew has to stop its car and wait for the instructions of the scrutineers and/or marshal. In the absence of scrutineers or marshals, the crew may leave the zone without stopping. A tyre mark checking zone may be established at the entrance of the authorised service parks and remote service zones.

#### 7.1.4 Means of control

Checks for compliance with this regulation may be undertaken at any time during the rally and any discrepancies will be reported to the stewards. A detailed information sheet will be available before each rally.

## 7.2 TYRES USED FOR RECONNAISSANCE

Only E- or DOT-approved homologated road legal tyres are allowed. Retreaded tyres are forbidden for reconnaissance. Any treatment (ie. removing or damaging) on road tyres side markings or texts is not allowed.

## 7.3 NATIONAL LAWS OR SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Not applicable.

## 8. FUEL

#### **8.1 FUEL RESTRICTIONS**

It is mandatory for participants to use Fuel in accordance with FIA Appendix K Article 3.9.

#### **8.2 REFUELLING**

## 8.2.1 All Competitors may only refuel in a Refuelling Zone (RZ) as indicated in the Road Book.

This refuelling zones will be located right after the Service Park exit.

Competitors' cars may be refuelled from drums/cans with commercially available fuel and two team members with team passes may access the RZ to assist each crew. The relevant personnel must be wearing clothing which will provide adequate protection against fire.

## 8.2.2 Refuelling in a commercial filling station

Refuelling in the commercial filling stations is allowed. Only the crew itself may refill the car.

## 8.2.3 Refuelling procedure

The complete refuelling procedure must be in compliance with Article 61.2 of the FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations.

When the refuelling is done by the competitor from their own fuel drums, the competitor is responsible to protect the ground with an Environmental Mat which shall be composed of an absorbent upper part and an impermeable lower part.

## 9. RECONNAISSANCE

## 9.1 PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION

No registration is required.





Reconnaissance material will be issued upon collection of the Road Book.

Details of the itinerary such onboard videos and start / finish locations will be published 3 months before the rally.

#### 9.1.1 Registration form

#### 9.1.2 Checking of Reconnaissance cars

Reconnaissance cars must comply with Art.35.1 of FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations.

#### 9.1.3 Reconnaissance identification

## 9.2.1 Safety tracking deposit

No deposit will be necessary for the GPS – Safety – Tracking system fitting.

#### 9.3 RECONNAISSANCE TIME SCHEDULE

The reconnaissance time schedule is free from 08/11/2021 to the 18/11/2021 at 18:00.

Competitors registering the 08/11/2021 will have time enough to perform at least 3 times each Special Stage.

The reconnaissance for SS10 CIRCUIT DE CATALUNYA will be possible on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> from 13h to 14h and Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup>, from 17h to 19h at maximum 80 km/h.

#### 9.4 RECONNAISSANCE RULES

The crews are obliged to follow all reconnaissance rules specified in FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations.

## 9.4.1 Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance will be organised in compliance with art. 35 of FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations and only series production cars conforming to art. 35.1 of FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations must be used.

## 9.4.2 Speed limit (Art. 34.2 of FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations):

The maximum speed set for the reconnaissance of the SS is 80 km/h, except for those areas in which there are speed limit signs or in built-up areas (from 30 km/h) or other limitations marked in the Road Book.

## 9.4.3 Direction

Each crew may drive the Special Stages only in the direction of the rally. The crews must always enter and leave the Special Stages through the start and stop controls.

## 9.4.4 Restriction of reconnaissance

Not applicable

## 9.4.5 Number of persons on board

During each passage through a Special Stage, a maximum of 2 persons (the crew) are permitted in the car.





#### 9.4.6 Number of passages

The number of passages is free.

## 9.4.7 Illegal reconnaissance

Not applicable.

## 9.4.8 Speeding

Speeding will be penalized according to the Art. 34.2 of FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations.

Speeding during reconnaissance will incur a fine applied by the clerk of the course as follows - per km per hour over the speed limit: **all drivers 25 EUR.** 

The fine will be doubled in case of a second offence committed during reconnaissance.

The police will report all the offences to the organisation. Speeding reports will be fined as above.

The stewards will decide for other infringements reported by the police.

## 9.4.9 Radar detection equipment

The fitting or carrying of radar detection equipment during reconnaissance is not permitted. Infringements will be reported to the stewards.

## 10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

## 10.1 DOCUMENTS TO BE PRESENTED (Virtually better than presentially)

At Administrative Checks the following documents will be checked and entry form details verified:

- Competitor's license
- Driver and Co-driver competition licenses
- Driver and Co-driver valid driving licence
- ASN authorisation (mandatory for all foreign Competitors and/or drivers)
- Completion of all details on the entry form
- Valid personal accident insurance of non-EU drivers
- Car registration papers
- Valid car's HTP (to be given to the secretariat)

## **10.2 TIMETABLE**

Thursday, 18/11/2021 from 08:00 to 13:00 and from 15:00 to 17:00

All Administrative Checks must be completed by 17:00 on Thursday, 18/11/2021 at Rally HQ. Only drivers and co-drivers must be present at Administrative Checks.





## 11. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

#### 11.1 SCRUTINEERING VENUE AND TIMETABLE

Venue: PAVELLO MUNICIPAL GIRONA – FONTAJAU. Av. Josep Tarradellas i Joan, 22-24 (GIRONA)

Date: Thursday, 18/11/2021 from 09:00 to 18:00

The detailed timetable for pre-rally scrutineering will be published in a Bulletin.

Any crew taking part in the rally, or their representative must arrive at the Scrutineering and present the car in accordance with the timetable to be issued in a Bulletin. Any lateness entering to pre-rally Scrutineering area will be sanctioned with a fine of 30 EUR for each 10 minutes delayed. Drivers and Co-drivers are not required to attend Scrutineering.

The cars must be fully prepared and ready for all necessary sealing and marking (Art 16.1.2 FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations), (if the car is not prepared for the sealing, the car will not be authorized to access to the Scrutineering and fine for lateness will be applicable):

• compressor (turbocharger) and the spare one for all compressor equipped cars; The dismantled underbody protectors must be kept with the car weight checks. Sealing wires must be installed according to the instructions given at a later date. Camera brackets will be checked at scrutineering.

#### 11.2 DOCUMENTS TO BE PRESENTED AT SCRUTINEERING:

- Vehicle registration document, when it's applicable;
- Letter of permission from the owner of the car, if he/she is not one of the drivers (not applicable to cars registered in Estonia);
- Valid vehicle insurance policy (e.g. Green Card);
- **Vehicle original FIA HTP.** In addition, homologation form for rollcage (if homologated) must be with the car at Scrutineering.

The crew must present the FIA HTP to the FIA eligibility delegate who will keep it until the end of the event. If this is not submitted, the car may not start.

## 11.3 DRIVERS' SAFETY EQUIPMENT

At Scrutineering Competitors must produce all items of protective clothing, underwear, including helmets and a FIA approved head restraint (FHR, formerly called HANS) intended to be used. Compliance with Appendix L Chapter III will be checked. The use of FHR in Category 1 is recommended but not mandatory. Any infringement will be penalised by the Stewards.

The use of driver's safety equipment may be checked at any time.

#### 11.4 INSTALLATION OF SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

The Anube tracking system will be fitted to the cars during Scrutineering by a marshal. In case of withdrawal the tracking system must be returned to the Sweeper car or to the HQ. At the end of the rally, the tracking system will be dismantled by a marshal at the Parc Ferme entrance.





## 12. OTHER PROCEDURES

## 12.1 CEREMONIAL START PROCEDURE

#### **Ceremonial Start procedure**

A Ceremonial Start will be organised on Thursday 18/11/2021 at 19h, in the Podium located in the Parking Rotonda Pont de Pedret (Girona).

A list for competitors allowed in the Ceremonial Start will be published in the Official Notice Board and the Virtual Notice Board, according increasing order of competition number. Every crew, driver and codriver must be present in the holding area located in the Parc Ferme at least 15 minutes before his scheduled time.

#### **12.2 FINISH PROCEDURE**

The cars will pass through the Finish Podium after TC 14c (Parc Ferme IN) and then will remain in Parc Ferme. Selected cars must be driven to the Final Scrutineering by the driver or mechanic.

On Sunday 21/11/2021 at 09:00 h the Prize-giving will take place in the Podium without the cars.

#### 12.3 PERMITTED EARLY CHECK-IN

Crews are authorised to check-in early without time penalty at:  ${\sf TC}$  7a and  ${\sf TC14c}$ 

#### 12.4 START PROCEDURE AND ORDER

#### 12.4.1 Starting order and intervals

The start order will be according to Article 41 of the FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations.

The interval between each car will be 1 minute.

The EHSRC competitors will start always before the other categories.

The TCO is located at the Service Park Exit. There is no Parc Ferme before the Start of the event. 15 minutes before due time, the competitors must collect the Time Card next to the TCO. The cars are requested to arrive to the holding area near the TCO between 15 and 10 minutes before due time.

## 12.4.2 Start procedure for Special Stages

According Art 48.1 of FIA EHRC, Start Procedure for Special Stages will be as follows:

A Start Clock with countdown will be placed in the start line. This Start Clock will be linked to a Cell Beam located 50 cm after the start line.

#### 12.4.3 Re-start after retirement / Catch-up

Re-start will be allowed under all provisions applied in Article 54 of FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations.

Any crew which has failed to complete Leg 1 can re-start the rally from the start of Leg 2 unless if they confirm otherwise to the Clerk of the Course prior to the publication of the start list of Leg 2 on Friday 19/11/2021 at 23:00.

The restarting car must report to the overnight Parc Fermé prior to Leg 2, on Saturday 20/11/2021 at 6:15. The re-scrutineering will take place at Parc Ferme at 6:45

#### 12.5 Circuit de Barcelona – Catalunya (SS10) procedures

In SS10, the competitors must follow the road-book. The SS consist in some laps around the racetrack, including some chicanes. Failure to complete the full itinerary of this SS will entail the disqualification of the competitor. Competitors doing more laps than planned in the road-book will have their full time without any additional penalty. Competitors being reported for shortcutting some of the chicanes of the circuit will have a 30 seconds penalty for each infringement.

## 12.6 Servicing of the cars

Servicing of the cars could be only performed in the Service Park or the Remote Service Zones. Service outside this areas is forbidden.





## 12.5 REMOVAL OF CARS FROM THE FINAL PARC FERMÉ

Cars may be removed from final Parc Fermé once the Stewards authorise its opening. Provided that the above takes place as scheduled, all cars must be removed no later than 13:00 on Sunday 21/11/2021

#### 12.6 OFFICIAL TIME USED DURING THE RALLY

Throughout the rally, the official time will be the satellite clock. UTC/GMT +1 hour

#### 12.7 TIME CARDS

**12.7**.1. New time cards will be issued to the Competitors at the following time controls: Service Park Exit before TC 0, TC 4a, TC 7b and TC 10a.

In TC0 and TC7b the new time cards will be issued 15 minutes before due time for each competitor.

**12.7.2.** Upon retiring, a crew must hand in its time card either to a marshal at a time Control or to the sweeping car.

## 12.8 – ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS BY THE ORGANISER IN THE CONTEXT OF COVID-19

The updated rules of PROCICAT and other national health authorities as well the rules from the National and Regional Federations will be announced in a bulletin well before the start of the event, and must be followed by all the stakeholders.

Prizegiving will take place without the cars but the presence of the driver and the codriver is mandatory.

## 15. FINAL CHECKS AND PROTESTS

#### 15.1 Final Scrutineering

Date: Saturday, 20113/2021 at 19h10'

Location: Auto Taller Alcalà. Ctra de Taialà 14 - 17007 GIRONA

Competitors who will be selected for final Scrutineering are requested to provide proper equipment (including all sealed spare parts) and mechanics at the Final Scrutineering venue.

Each selected car will be driven to Final Scrutineering by a designated member of the team (who must be present at the finish), and accompanied by an official.

In case of a protest, the said car will be checked at the same venue.

#### **15.2 PROTEST DEPOSIT**

The protest deposit is €1,000 (FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations - Art. 65.2).

If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of the car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit:

**15.2.1** For a protest involving only a clearly defined part of the car (engine, transmission, steering, braking system, electrical installation, body work, etc.): additional deposit € 750 each part of the car.

**15.2.2** For a protest involving the whole car: additional deposit € 4,000.

## **15.3 APPEAL DEPOSIT**

The sum for an international appeal deposit (FIA) is: € 3,000.00.



## **APPENDIX 5. CHAPTER III DRIVERS' EQUIPMENT OF APPENDIX L 2021**

Flame-Resistant Clothing / Head restraints / Helmets (FIA ISC, Appendix L, Chapter III, articles 1, 2 and 3)

#### • FLAME-RESISTANT CLOTHING

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard, (Technical List N°27) and FIA 8856-2018 standard (Technical List N°24).

Users must ensure that garments are not too tight, as this reduces the level of protection. Embroidery sewn directly onto the overalls shall be stitched onto the outermost layer only, for better heat

insulation. Backing material of badges and thread used for affixing them to the overalls must be flameproof (see Appendix 1 of the FIA 8856-2000 Standard for detailed requirements and instructions for use).

## • FRONTAL HEAD RESTRAINT (FHR)

The use of frontal head restraints, homologated according to the FIA 8858-2010 or 8858-2002 standard is mandatory for all drivers / co-drivers of Categories 2 / 3 / 4 and recommended for drivers and co-drivers of Category 1. Homologated FHR systems are listed in the FIA Technical List N° 29.

#### **Conditions of use**

FHR systems must be worn only with FIA-approved items according to the following chart:

Helmet (2)	FHR system (tether, tether end fitting and helmet anchorage)
FIA 8860- <u>2018</u> (Technical List № 69) FIA 8860- <u>2010</u> (Technical List № 33) FIA 8858 <u>-2010</u> (Technical List № 41) FIA 8859-2015 (Technical list № 49)	FIA 8858-2010 (Technical List № 29)

(2) Mandatory wearing of helmets in each championship according to Appendix L, Chapter III, Article 1.1.

#### • HEI METS

All drivers must wear crash helmets that meet one of the standards in FIA Technical List N°25, but are also compatible with FHR system (FIA 8858-2010 or 8858-2002 standard) and are thus contained in FIA Technical Lists N°33 and 41. However, it is strongly recommended, that they wear helmets meeting the FIA 8860-2004 or 8860-2010 - Advanced Helmet Test Specification (FIA Technical List N°33) standard.

Clothing and equipment will be checked at Scrutineering and at any other time during the rally.
